There are about twenty thousand different types of butterflies all over the world. Butterflies go through a life cycle. There are four stages. It starts off as an egg. A female butterfly lays eggs on leaves.

The second stage is the caterpillar, also known as the larva stage. It takes about five days for the eggs to hatch into caterpillars. A caterpillar will eat leaves all day until it is fully grown.

The pupa stage, which is the third stage, starts once the caterpillar is fully grown. The caterpillar will hang itself on a branch and change into a chrysalis. It is also called a pupa. It will remain in the cocoon for about two weeks. Then it will be ready to become a butterfly.

When the caterpillar turns into a butterfly, the fourth stage of its life cycle starts. It will fly to flowers to sip nectar. It will also lay eggs and the life cycle of the butterfly will begin all over again.
