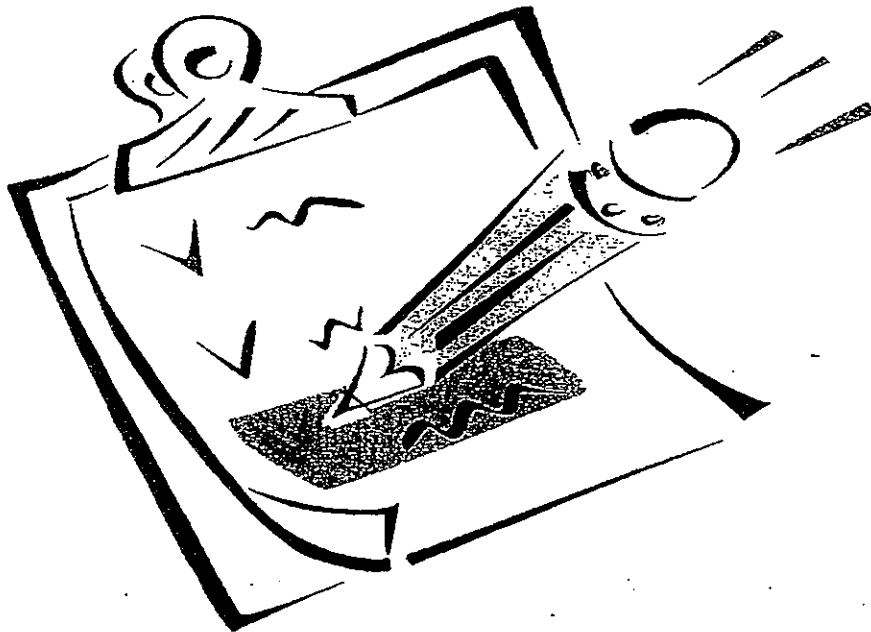

The giraffe is the tallest land animal. It can grow to a height of six metres tall. It has a pair of sharp eyes to help it sense danger from far. Other animals such as the zebras and deer often gather around the giraffe to stay away from danger.

Giraffes are found in open grasslands in Africa. They feed on leaves on the trees and can go without water for weeks. Giraffes get most of the water they need from the plants they eat. They take turns to eat and drink so that at least one giraffe in the herd helps to look out for predators. They are careful not to be caught by the lions.

Female giraffes in the herd help to take care of their calves. Before a lion can attack a calf, its mother will position herself over the calf to protect it. She will use her powerful front legs with sharp hooves to put an end to the lion's life.
