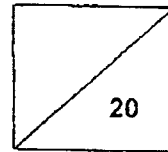

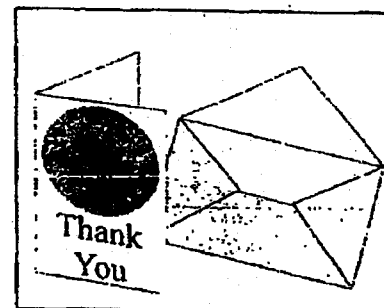
Write a composition of at least 120 words about being a good friend.

You may use the points in any order and include other relevant points as well.

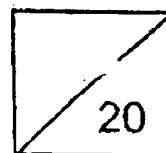
